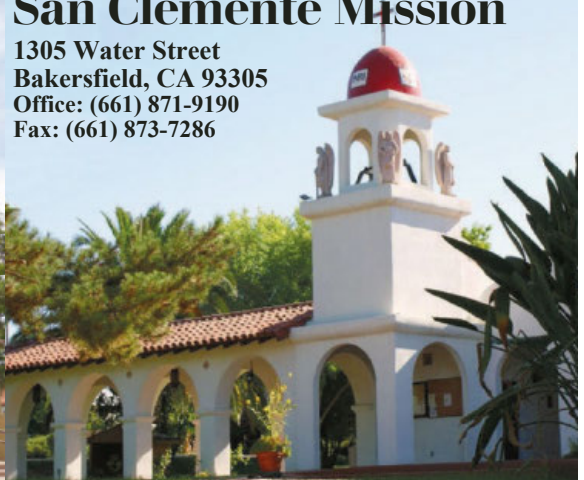

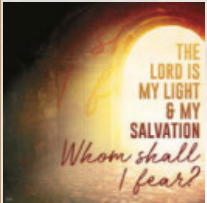

Sunday Connection

First Reading: *Acts of the Apostles 10:34a,37-43*

Peter preaches about Jesus' life, death, and resurrection.

Responsorial Psalm: *Psalm 118:1-2,16-17,22-23* *Rejoice in this day of the Lord.*

Second Reading: *Colossians 3:1-4* or *1 Corinthians 5:6b-8*

Colossians: Having been raised by Christ, be concerned with what is above.

1 Corinthians: Let us celebrate this feast with new yeast.

Gospel Reading: John 20:1-9

Mary of Magdala finds that the stone has been removed from Jesus' tomb.

Today we begin the Easter Season, our 50-day meditation on the mystery of Christ's Resurrection. Our Gospel today tells us about the disciples' discovery of the empty tomb. It concludes by telling us that they did not yet understand that Jesus had risen from the dead. Thus, the details provided are not necessarily meant to offer proof of the Resurrection. The details invite us to reflect upon a most amazing gift, that is faith in Jesus and his Resurrection.

Each of the four Gospels tells us that Jesus' empty tomb was first discovered by women. This is notable because in

first-century Jewish society women could not serve as legal witnesses. In the case of John's Gospel, the only woman attending the tomb is Mary of Magdala. Unlike the Synoptic accounts, John's Gospel does not describe an appearance of angels at the tomb. Instead, Mary is simply said to have observed that the stone that had sealed the tomb had been moved, and she runs to alert Simon Peter and the beloved disciple. Her statement to them is telling. She assumes that Jesus' body has been removed, perhaps stolen. She does not consider that Jesus has been raised from the dead.

Simon Peter and the beloved disciple race to the tomb, presumably to verify Mary's report. The beloved disciple arrives first but does not enter the tomb until after Simon Peter. This detail paints a vivid picture, as does the detail provided about the burial cloths. Some scholars believe that the presence of the burial cloths in the tomb offers evidence to the listener that Jesus' body had not been stolen (it is understood that grave robbers would have taken the burial cloths together with the body).

The Gospel passage concludes, however, that even having seen the empty tomb and the burial cloths, the disciples do not yet understand about the Resurrection. In the passage that follows, Mary of Magdala meets Jesus but mistakes him for the gardener. In the weeks ahead, the Gospel readings from our liturgy will show us how the disciples came to believe in Jesus' Resurrection through his appearances to them. Our Easter faith is based on their witness to both the empty tomb and their continuing relationship with Jesus—in his appearances and in his gift of the Holy Spirit.

Conexión Dominical

Hoy comenzamos el tiempo de Pascua, nuestra meditación de 50 días sobre el misterio de la resurrección de Cristo.

Nuestro Evangelio de hoy nos habla del descubrimiento de la tumba vacía por parte de los discípulos. Concluye diciéndonos que aún no entendían que Jesús había resucitado de entre los muertos. Por lo tanto, los detalles

proporcionados no están necesariamente destinados a ofrecer una prueba de la Resurrección. Los detalles nos invitan a reflexionar sobre un don asombroso, que es la fe en Jesús y su resurrección.

Cada uno de los cuatro Evangelios nos dice que la tumba vacía de Jesús fue descubierta por primera vez por mujeres. Esto es notable porque en la sociedad judía del primer siglo las mujeres no podían servir como testigos legales. En el caso del Evangelio de Juan, la única mujer que asiste a la tumba es María de Magdala. A diferencia de los relatos sinópticos, el Evangelio de Juan no describe una aparición de ángeles en la tumba.

En cambio, simplemente se dice que María observó que la piedra que había sellado la tumba había sido movida, y corre a alertar a Simón Pedro y al discípulo amado. Su declaración para ellos es reveladora. Ella asume que el cuerpo de Jesús ha sido removido, tal vez robado. Ella no considera que Jesús haya resucitado de entre los muertos.

Simón Pedro y el discípulo amado corren a la tumba, presumiblemente para verificar el informe de María. El discípulo amado llega primero, pero no entra en la tumba hasta después de Simón Pedro. Este detalle pinta una imagen vívida, al igual que el detalle proporcionado sobre los lienzos funerarios. Algunos eruditos creen que la presencia de los lienzos funerarios en la tumba ofrece evidencia al oyente de que el cuerpo de Jesús no había sido robado (se entiende que los ladrones de tumbas habrían tomado los lienzos funerarios junto con el cuerpo).

El pasaje del Evangelio concluye, [diciéndonos], que [aun después de haber] visto la tumba vacía y los lienzos funerarios, los discípulos aún no entienden acerca de la Resurrección. En el pasaje que sigue, María de Magdala se encuentra con Jesús, pero lo confunde con el jardinero. En las próximas semanas, las lecturas del Evangelio de nuestra liturgia nos mostrarán cómo los discípulos llegaron a creer en la resurrección de Jesús a través de sus apariciones a ellos. Nuestra fe pascual se basa en su testimonio tanto de la tumba vacía como de su relación continua con Jesús, en sus apariciones y en su don del Espíritu Santo.

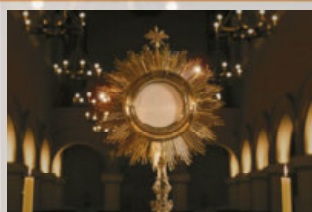
